White Wines

- 1. Chenin Blanc, Drakensberg – South Africa**
Typical flavours of grapefruit and honey, with a finish that is just off dry.

- 2. Pinot Grigio, Pure Range – Italy**
A lighter, steelier expression of Pinot Grigio, unoaked and crisp at first, but the palate evolves into a riper, nuttier character by the finish.

- 3. Sauvignon Blanc, El Picador – Chile**
Good colour, nice forward nose with distinct gooseberry and lime character.

- 4. Semillon/Chardonnay, Eagles Point – Australia**
Soft, rounded and loaded with brash tropical fruit and a touch of oak.

- 5. Viognier, Las, Mendoza – Argentina**
Soft, grapey and medium in style with a refreshing lime zest quality that cleans the palate.

- 6. Grillo, Pure Range, Sicily – Italy**
A soft, pleasantly fruity dry white with a subtle nutty character and hints of apple.

- 7. Chardonnay, Pitch Fork, McLaren Vale – Australia**
Bursting with aromatics of pineapple, lime and spring blossom. Plenty of mid palate weight and finishing with clean crisp acid.

- 8. Rioja Blanco, Bodegas Muerza – Spain**
Unoaked, crisp, steely and refreshing with a clean, rapier-like acidity and a hint of grapefruit.

- 9. Sauvignon Blanc, Kuraka, Marlborough – New Zealand**
Zesty gooseberry, fresh flavours with hints of passion fruit. The palate is lively, with racy acid and typical length.

- 10. Chablis, Domaine Philippe Testut, Burgundy – France**
A beautiful full flavoured wine, elegant and classy with a lingering finish on the palate.

Red Wines

11. Merlot, El Picador – Chile

Ripe, compact, full of flavour and a long finish.

12. Drakesberg Cinsault / Cabernet – South Africa

Rich, jammy and smooth with a soft blackcurrant pastille fruit, a hint of warm spice and a gentle finish.

13. Shiraz Cabernet, Eagles Point – Australia

Medium-deep colour. Savoury with cherry fruit aromas with some dark chocolate and cigar box characters.

14. Malbec/Shiraz Las Manitos – Argentina

Dark, dense and jammy with a core of sweet cassis, plum and coffee fruit. Wonderfully lush and rounded.

15. Pinot Noir, Las Manitos – Argentina

Deep red ruby colour with intense raspberry and strawberry fruit on the nose.

16. Shiraz, Pitch Fork, McLaren Vale – Australia

Bright deep garnet with brick red hue. Aromas of blackcurrant, cassis and mulberry. The palate has soft tannins surrounded by a layer of red fruit and hint of spice.

17. Nero d'Avola, Pure Range, Puglia – Italy

A nicely balanced soft, easy drinking red made from the port-like Nero grape. Hints of black fruits, mulberry, raisin and spice.

18. Cabernet Sauvignon, Domaine de la Citadelle – France

The wine is rich, powerful and fruity yet distinctly reminiscent of the Luberon. Coming from a part of the vineyards known as 'Le Castellet', this is Cabernet that reflects its terroir rather than the varietal.

19. Rioja Crianza, Bodegas Muerza – Spain

Garnet-red of medium depth. Aromas of red fruit, blueberries and liquorice that blend nicely with toasty vanilla notes from ageing.

20. Malbc Lunta Mendel, Mendoza – Argentina

Vivacious violet red colour. Fresh and intense on the nose. Violets, cherries and plum aromas predominate.

21. Fleurie, Domaine Pardon, Burgundy – France

Wonderful soft nose of warm Gamay fruit and on the palate the earthy wild strawberry flavours drift through and linger quite magnificently.

22. Boulevard Blush, California – USA

Soft, pleasantly fruity with a medium, sweet finish, this has the hallmark raspberry and green leaf characters of Zinfandel in a nicely pink way!
